YOUR Club Championship, the final individual special event of the year, will be played on Wed., Nov 8 at The Preserve & Thur., Nov 9 at Mountain View

8:00am shotgun start both days; Luncheon at MV Ballroom on Nov 9

Hole-in-One Competition BOTH DAYS for a new Lexus from Lexus at the Auto Mall and a new golf cart from Golf Cars of Arizona

We will be playing from 3 sets of tees this year; the Gold/Black-Purple Club Championship Tees, the Gold-Platinum/Purple Mixed Tees, and the Platinum/Green Forward Tees. Any player playing from the Club Championship tees will be eligible to win the Club Championship (low cumulative gross). Our Club Champion will get a bonus payout and receive the Club Championship Trophy. There will be no low net club champion. However, the player with the lowest cumulative net playing from the Championship Tees will receive a bonus payout and an appropriate trophy. There will be flight winners and payouts for all tees played.

Format: Individual combined stroke play, **Gross & Net**, over both days with full course handicaps based on 11/1 handicap index. Day 2 pairings will be based on Day 1 performance and will be available on the website late Wednesday afternoon.

A typical flight of 8-12 players, grouped by course handicap, will pay out four places (You can only win one) for (1) low Gross, (2) low Net, (3) 2nd low Gross, and (4) 2nd low Net. Players will be grouped into flights by handicap; you will only compete against members who are playing from the same tees you choose. If there is a tie for the overall low gross 2-day score from the Club Championship tees, there will be an immediate sudden-death playoff starting on Hole #1 at Mountain View to determine the Club Champion. All other ties, will be broken by scorecard playoff, consistent with USGA guidelines (i.e., Day 2 18-hole score, then holes 10-18, then holes 13-18, then 16-18, then 18th hole). As one of our major events, the handicap committee will post the score for you for both days as a tournament (T) score.

\$35 Entry Fee: Complete the Entry Form below, attach your \$35 check made out to MPMGA, and place it in the MPMGA box, now located in the Mountain View pro shop, after October 10 between the hours of 6:30 a.m. and 2:00 p.m. Entry fee covers event prize money, 2 sets of \$10 KPs both days, Hole-in-One opportunities for a new Lexus & a new golf cart BOTH days of the event, and a luncheon (with beer) on Thursday, Nov 9 in the MV Ballroom. [Note: Entry fee assumes the player is an annual; if not, additional greens fees apply.]

Luncheon Menu: BBQ luncheon with all the trimmings, BEER, iced tea, and lemonade, and a dessert.
